

Chronic Pain Management & Functional Restoration Program

Our Chronic Pain Management (CPM) Program approach to pain and disability reflects the belief that everyday stress and mood can contribute to physical pain. Unrelenting pain may become a stressor in and of itself. Our program is designed to help the individual take control of his/her well being, in order to break out of the pain cycle. These treatment protocols have proven to show an increase in function and decrease on the dependancy of healthcare.

Functional Restoration Program (FRP) is an interdisciplinary, individualized, job specific program with the primary goal of returning to work. FRP also uses real or simulated work tasks, progressively graded conditioning exercises, pain management coaching techniques, and medication management that is based on the individual's needs and measured tolerances.

Outpatient Medical Rehab Program

Outpatient Medical Rehab Program (OMRP) is individualized, with the goal of increasing the overall function of the patient. The treatment team is picked after the patient completes a multidisciplinary evaluation, where the deficits are addressed and goals are set with the patient and team. OMRP is usually structured 3-5 days a week, between 2 and 6 hours a day. Most programs are 2-6 weeks in length.
